

YOSANNE VELLA

Yosanne Vella is a professor in history pedagogy within the Faculty of Education at the University of Malta. She is a history teacher trainer and she lectures on various topics on history and history teaching. She is also a history pedagogy specialist but also a historian who has written various papers on women's history, in particular on the theme of 18th century Maltese women.

She was the vice-chair of the Education and Culture Committee of NGOs at the Council of Europe up to 2014. She is one of the editors of the online textbook *Historiana* published by the European Association of History (EUROCLIO), the European History Educators' Network and one of EUROCLIO's ambassadors. She is also on the editorial board of a number of journals including the *International History Journal of The History Educators' International Research Network* (HEIRNET).

She has published various books, textbooks, papers and teaching resources on history education as well as a number of history papers on Maltese history and historiography.

She was the vice-president of the Malta Historical Society up to March 2019 and is presently acting president of the Maltese History Teachers' Association.
