

MAREK MORA

Marek Mora worked briefly in the Czech private sector after graduating in international trade from the University of Economics. He then completed his postgraduate studies in economics in Saarbrücken and Hamburg and taught at the University of Leipzig. In 1999, he was awarded the title of “Young Economist of the Year 1998”.



In 2003, he joined the Directorate-General for Economic and Financial Affairs of the European Commission and three years later started to work for the Czech public administration. He was Deputy Minister of Education for almost a year and then spent two and a half years at the Government Office – first as a deputy to the Deputy Prime Minister, later as Minister for European Affairs and then briefly as an adviser to Prime Minister Jan Fischer. From 2010, he worked at the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union – initially as the head of the Cabinet of the Secretary-General of the Council and, from February 2016, as the head of the Budget, Tax and Regional Policy Directorate.

Mr Mora became a member of the Bank’s Board of the Czech National Bank on 13 February 2017. The President appointed him Czech National Bank Deputy Governor with effect from 1 December 2018.
